1. Can we propose programming just for the educational portion of the RFP for both youth and adults (outlined in Section A and B of the Overview)?  
**Yes, you can submit a proposal and it will be scored against the rubric in the RFP.**
2. Additionally, can this response be submitted to you electronically? Or will the final submission need to be a physical copy sent to the department?  
**As mentioned in the RFP, both physical and electronic copies are required.**
3. Budget Documentation. Please clarify whether Attachments B–E (Estimated In-Kind Costs, Budget Information Form, Proposed Budget, and Direct Programmatic Costs) should be completed separately for Adult/Dislocated Worker and Youth Programs, or whether only Attachment D (Proposed Budget) must be submitted separately by program (as noted on the form).  
**Only, Attachment D must be submitted separately by program.**
4. Audit. For Section X.F. Monitoring and Self-Evaluation, Questions 3 and 4 reference the proposer's audit plan and submission of audit findings. Is the Board specifically referring to financial and Single Audit activities, or should proposers also address programmatic monitoring reviews, compliance audits, and corrective action processes related to workforce program operations?  
**Both should be addressed.**
